(Need to sign up for a min. of 2-5 courses)</p> <p>*Students have two options for testing:<br/> 1) At BYU testing sites.<br/> 2) From BYU website.</p> <p>Look on the website for a proctor close to you and make arrangements. Usually a \$35 fee. Tests must be ordered in advance.
