For all Honors classes, students will need to review their current or most recent GPA, Citizenship grades, SRI scores, and SAGE scores. The Counseling Center can provide SRI and SAGE test scores to students if needed. Enrollment into Honors courses is based on your cumulative scores between your GPA, Citizenship, SRI, SAGE, and Teacher Recommendation. These scores are then placed into a rubric to determine eligibility for applicable Honors classes.

Course Description:

Prerequisite: Instructor approval

This course is designed for students who have been identified as requiring more advanced instruction in reading comprehension, writing, and methods of inquiry as found in the core. This course will focus on the processes, skills, and strategies for effective communication in all its forms.

CRITERIA FOR APPLYING: There are only a certain amount of honors classes each year. Student GPA, Citizenship, SRI, SAGE, and Teacher Recommendation scores are combined to assign a total score. Students will then be ranked according to their total score. Language Arts will take as many students as they can for the allotted number of honors sections for the next year in the order of student ranking. Any students below the cut off will be put on a waiting list.

Students that are elected for this class can expect a summer homework assignment that will consist of reading a difficult book and writing several essays before the start of school in August.

For all honors classes, students will need to review their current GPA, SRI, and SAGE Scores.
