

8th Grade Job Shadow Experience

Dear Parents/Students:

On Wednesday, October 16, 2019, our 8th-grade students will be participating in a Job Shadow Experience. Job shadowing is a dynamic program where students spend a day at a business in the community

observing one or more persons doing a real-world job. Job shadowing gives students the opportunity to explore a career interest as students begin to think about the different options available to them.



Students and their parents will be responsible for arranging a Job Shadow Experience, as well as the transportation to and from the job shadow site. The experience should also be a minimum of 4 hours. The “Disclosure, Acknowledgment, and Information” form must be completed and returned to the Counseling Center before students may participate in this work-based learning experience. During the job shadow, students are asked to complete a Job Shadow Assignment for credit. This assignment will count for all assignments at school that day. Students who complete their Job Shadow Assignment and return it to the Counseling Center by Friday, October 18th by 7:45 AM will be entered into a drawing to win some awesome College/Career themed prizes. This year there is a grand prize of \$100 to go toward a College Fund!

Since this is a school activity, students will be excused from school in order to participate (as long as the “Disclosure, Acknowledgment, and Information” form is completed and returned to the Counseling Center prior to October 16th). It is expected that all 8th-grade students participate in this activity. Because 8th graders are attending the Job Shadow Experience, 8th-grade classes will not be held on October 16th. Any 8th graders who do come to school that day will be assigned to the Media Center to work on a Job Shadow Packet.

The Job Shadow Experience will count for all schoolwork and assignments in each class on October 16th, the day of the Job Shadow. To get credit for assignments/work in class, students must complete the Job Shadow Experience. Students who do not complete the Job Shadow Experience will receive zero credit for coursework in classes that day.

The CMMS counselors are excited to provide this opportunity for career exploration to our 8th-grade students. We also appreciate all the parent help in supporting your student! The enclosed information will give you details to help you or your student *prepare for* and *complete* the Job Shadow Experience! 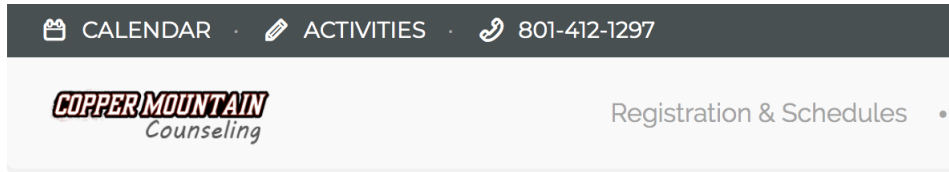

CRITICAL INFORMATION for YOUR JOB SHADOW

- You will be excused from school on October 16th to participate in a Job Shadow. Doing this activity will count for all of your homework and assignments for that day at school.
- You are in charge of arranging your own transportation to and from your Job Shadow.
- Your Job Shadow should be at least 4 hours long (travel time is included in this time).
- You must turn in your “Disclosure, Acknowledgement, and Information Form” (enclosed in this packet) to the Counseling Center by 3:00 pm on Tuesday, October 15th.
- Complete the “Job Shadow Assignment” for a chance to be entered into a drawing on October 18th. You must turn in your assignment by Friday, October 18th by 7:45 AM, to the Counseling Center. *Grand Prize \$100 scholarship for a college savings account!
- Think about jobs that interest you and try those places first as you set up your Job Shadow.
